2 HEARING OFFICER TRACY: Do either of you  
3 gentlemen have any closing statements?

4 MR. ROBINSON LOFFLER: No, sir.

5 HEARING OFFICER TRACY: Okay. At this point  
6 the evidentiary and testimonial exhibits are entered  
7 into the record. The record is closed. The Board  
8 will deliberate with regard to the record it has  
9 before it and they will make a recommendation to the  
10 Commissioner of Labor, who will then issue an Order  
11 and Determination with regard to the Department's  
12 request.

13 MR. LEACH: Thank you.

14 HEARING OFFICER TRACY: Let's go off the  
15 record.

16 (Discussion off the record.)

17 HEARING OFFICER TRACY: The members of the  
18 Crane Board have reviewed the evidence and the  
19 testimony, and it is their opinion that their report  
20 and recommendation to the Commissioner is that  
21 Mr. Hendrickson did not engage in any improper or  
22 negligent activity when operating his crane and that  
23 he remains a person of the proper competence,  
24 judgment and ability to operate a crane and that,  
25 therefore, no further action should be taken by the

1 Department with regard to possible suspension,  
2 revocation or refusal to renew his crane operator's  
3 certificate of competence.

4 Board members, is that a fair summary of  
5 your position with regard to this matter?

6 MR. ALGER: Yes.

7 MR. RUPERT: Yes.

8 HEARING OFFICER TRACY: Thank you. That  
9 will be the Board's report and recommendation to the  
10 Commissioner of Labor, who will then issue her Order  
11 and Determination. Thank you.
